

# Asbestos Awareness (Category A) eLearning Training

Asbestos is probably the most dangerous building material ever used. Every year thousands of people fall ill and die because of exposure to asbestos and it was widely used by the construction industry right up until the year 2000.

The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 applies to employers, employees, self-employed persons and duty holders and cover all work with asbestos containing materials (ACMs).

Regulation 10 of CAR states that every employer must ensure that adequate information, instruction and training is given to employees who are liable to be exposed to asbestos. This includes maintenance workers and others who may come into contact with or disturb asbestos.

## Course Aims

By the end of this course learners will:

- Understand why ACMs can be harmful and must be treated as a hazardous substance.
- Understand the health effects that asbestos can have.
- Understand the measures needed to eliminate or reduce the risks from asbestos.
- Know the responsibilities of employers and employees under legislation.
- Understand the necessary emergency procedures.

## Course Detail

Duration: 65 minutes

This course covers all areas of asbestos awareness and is designed for anyone who may come into contact with asbestos in their work. Most commonly, that includes builders, plumbers, electricians, carpenters and other building related and maintenance trades.

The course consists of 4 modules with questions at the end. The modules cover areas such as recognising asbestos, where it is used, minimising the risks and legislation about working with asbestos.
