

Working Safely at Height Training

Legislation provides that employers provide training and instruction or take other additional suitable and sufficient measures to prevent, so far as is practicable, any employee falling a distance liable to cause personal injury.

This Working Safely at Height course has been designed for staff that use a roof area for their work, including maintenance personnel, property managers and building owners.

This practical course is delivered on-site over 2-3 hours (dependant on the number of delegates) by our expert instructors.



Course Aims

The course aims to enable delegates to work safely at height using appropriate Personal Fall Prevention Equipment (PFPE); Suspended Access Systems (SAS) and Fall Prevention Systems (FPS).

Objectives

Delegates will acquire the knowledge and skills to:

- Understand the relevant legislation;
- Know the correct way to fit a harness;
- Recognise the correct use of PFPE;
- Identify principles of care, maintenance and storage of PFPE;
- Know what to do in a fall incident;
- Identify the components of systems on a roof.

Certification

This course completes with a written test. Upon successful completion of the practical elements and passing the written test, delegates are presented with a certificate from HBE.

Please note that in tandem with our efforts to be more environmentally friendly and in line with our ISO14001 targets, certificates will be submitted in electronic format. Hard copies of certificates can be provided at an additional cost.

Course detail

This course is delivered on-site, which means that we can be flexible with timings to fit in with your schedule.

There is a minimum requirement for 3 delegates and a maximum of 6 per training session.

The course must be run in a dedicated quiet area or training room on-site, where the delegates can concentrate without distraction.



The instructor and delegates will need safe access to the roof area for the delivery of the practical elements of the course. The instructor will require access to the roof at least one hour before the scheduled training start time.

If roof access is via temporary ladders, it is imperative that delegates are trained on the inspection, use and maintenance of temporary ladder systems prior to this training.

Participants must have access to suitable PFPE for the training (Two sets are acceptable as a minimum). HBE can supply Safety harnesses and other PFPE for purchase. Please advise at the time of booking if PFPE is required.

Delegates should dress in appropriate attire for wearing a harness and using a roof.

HBE will highlight any areas of risk identified during the training, however, the instructor reserves the right to cancel the training should the access route to the roof be deemed unsafe.
